CLASS SCHEDULE: 2008 - 2009

We are pleased to announce the following Class Schedule for Beginner's Classes in Iconography:

Sherry Lynch, Master Iconographer and Instructor at the Institute will teach all classes. Class sizes will be limited to a maximum of 12 students. Classes are conducted in relative silence, as a spiritual journey and always start with group prayer. Classes are open to all Christians of any tradition, **over the age of 18.** From time to time, former students may join in as 'paint-in" companions; they are not considered "faculty". These iconographers will each be working on their own icons and will be offering their own prayerful support to the students,

NOTE: If it is determined by the Director that insufficient numbers of students have registered for any class, then that class may be cancelled.

SUMMER CLASS: A one-week class beginning on Monday, August 4, 2008. Classes begin at 8.30 am and recess daily at 3 pm. A lunch period of 30 minutes is taken. Students may either bring lunch or order from a no-host deli menu. Deli lunches will be delivered to the Cathedral and soft drinks & refreshments will be provided. **Register by July 21, 2008.**

FALL CLASS: A series of 12 nights, beginning on Monday, September 22, 2008 and running for 12 weeks. Classes begin at 6.30 pm and continue until 9 pm each evening. **Register by September 8, 2008.**

SPRING CLASS: A series of 12 nights, beginning on Monday, March 2, 2009 and running for 12 weeks. Classes begin at 6.30 pm and continue until 9 pm each evening. **Register by February 16, 2009.**

SUMMER CLASS: A one-week class beginning on Monday, August 17, 2009. Classes begin at 8.30 am and recess daily at 3 pm. A lunch period of 30 minutes is taken. Students may either bring lunch or order from a no-host deli menu. Deli lunches will be delivered to the Cathedral and soft drinks & refreshments will be provided. **Register by August 3, 2009.**

FALL CLASS: **No Fall class will be offered in 2009**

FEES: Tuition fees for any of the above classes are \$150. In addition, students will contribute \$15 for Administrative costs. Supplies costs will be in addition to the fees. Tuition fees and Administrative costs may be tax deductible.

LOCATION: All classes are held in Bishop Scott room, in the lower part of Trinity Cathedral's Parish House (adjacent to the Cathedral). Trinity Cathedral is located at 147 NW 19th Street, Portland, Oregon (corner of NW 19th Avenue and Everett Street.)

PARKING: Trinity owns three parking lots adjacent to the Cathedral. One is directly in front, and one is immediately beside, the Cathedral on NW 19th Street and one is behind the Cathedral campus on NW Trinity Place. Free parking passes, if needed, will be issued on the first day of class. Handicapped parking spaces or assistance with Cathedral access are available upon request.

REGISTRATION: Registration for all classes is on a "first-come-first served" basis. **Tuition fees must be paid in full and a Registration form submitted before a student is considered Registered; they must be received BY THE SPECIFIED REGISTRATION DATE** and made on the accompanying form. CANCELLATIONS: To obtain a full refund of all Tuition and Administrative fees, cancellations must be made **no later than 14 days** prior to the class starting date. Cancellations after that grace period may be subject to a reduction in the refund amount unless a replacement student is obtained.
